On this day, the University of Siegen offers a diverse program on the topic of „internationalization“ for different target groups. The offers of the Faculty of Humanities are aimed at prospective students and students from Germany and abroad.

At 9:30, the first session in [room 3](#) on the topic of **International Bachelor Programs** will begin: Prof.in Britta Thörle and Britta Gemmeke will present the bi-national Bachelor program „[B.A. European Business Communication - Langues, communication et commerce européens](#)“, which is funded by the Franco-German University and leads to a German-French degree. The four-year bachelor's program „[B.A. Social Sciences in Europe](#)“ with a focus on transnationality and globalization will then be presented by Thomas Güte and Dr. Bettina Grimmer. The integrated year abroad at a partner university offers a concrete and practical insight into the diversity of Europe.

For example, both exchange students and local students benefit from the [MAX mentoring program](#). Prof. Dr. Daniel Stein, Vice Dean for International Affairs, will present the key figures of the internationalization of the faculty and partner universities and Dr. des Luz Pacas will give an overview of the offers for incoming exchange students, outgoing students and students from Siegen. This session will be held in English, as everyone interested in international exchange is invited. No matter if you are an exchange student coming from abroad and studying or would like to study in Siegen, if you are planning a stay abroad or if you simply want to get in touch with students from abroad, this session will provide a comprehensive insight into what opportunities the Faculty of Humanities offers its students.

In the third session, starting at 5:00 p.m., **International Master Programs in Social Sciences and Economics**, Prof. Dr. Christian Lahusen will present the international, interdisciplinary, research-oriented English-language master's program „[Roads to Democracies Historical and Contemporary Perspectives on Politics and Culture](#)“. This study program is aimed at bachelor students of history, political or social sciences or a comparable subject from Germany and abroad who are interested in the connections between institutional structures, political processes and the cultural and social foundations of democracies. Students in the master's program will share their experiences and will be available to answer questions.
